

## Warm Welcome Bench

Is your entryway missing something? Add some functionality and design with an updated bench project.



### MATERIALS:

- Old or secondhand wooden bench
- Drop cloth or old sheets
- Medium-grit sandpaper
- Lint-free cloth or paper towel
- Painter's Touch® Ultra Cover 2x Primer Spray
- Painter's Touch Ultra Cover 2x Gloss Spray Paint (colour of your choice)
- Painter's Touch Ultra Cover 2x Spray Paint in Flat Matte Clear

### STEPS:

1. Enlist some neighbourly help to move your bench and get it set up in a well-ventilated area. Be sure to cover your workspace with drop cloths or old sheets to protect any nearby items from overspray.
2. Lightly sand the wooden bench, removing any old paint chips or snags. Wipe clean all dirt and debris.
3. Create a solid base using Painter's Touch Ultra Cover 2x Primer Spray. Hold the can 25-40 cm (10-16") from the surface, covering the bench in a steady back-and-forth motion, slightly overlapping each stroke. As always, follow the manufacturer's recommendations on preparation, application, dry time and clean up.
4. Once the bench is fully dry, apply a coat of Painter's Touch Ultra Cover 2x Gloss Spray Paint in a colour of your choice. Apply a second coat, if necessary, within 1 hour or after 24 hours.
5. For extra protection, apply one coat of Painter's Touch Ultra Cover 2x Spray in Flat Matte Clear.
6. When everything is fully dried set up your bench in your entryway and just wait for guests to arrive!
